This is in response to your letter of March 31, 2009, to Craig Lewis, Norfolk Southern's vice president for corporate affairs.

Because it is in the long-term interests of Norfolk Southern – employees, customers and shareholders – the company is fully committed to the Dillerville Yard relocation project as it is currently designed. Governor Edward G. Rendell through his public statements and actions has confirmed that his administration strongly supports the project and will provide the funding necessary for the initiative to proceed on schedule, noting the project's importance to the Lancaster area and the Commonwealth.

The remediation of the property is being managed by ARM Group on behalf of Franklin & Marshall College and Lancaster General pursuant to a comprehensive plan that was reviewed and approved by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Norfolk Southern expects that work to be done in compliance with the approved plan.
