Dear Resident:

We wrote to you in December to announce that the environmental remediation of the Lancaster Solid Waste Management property will begin this month. Days Cove Reclamation Company, the environmental remediation contractor, will be using the paved road on Franklin & Marshall College's Brickyard parcel to access the site creating a construction area extending from the end of Vermont Avenue to the underpass at the railroad tracks.

In order to comply with OSHA and construction safety regulations, we will be posting the Brickyard property with additional no trespassing signs in the near future. We recognize that a number of residents use the Brickyard parcel for recreational purposes. However, to maintain public safety as the construction vehicles begin to use this road during the project, we must prohibit all non-construction use of the property, including public access to the paved road, until the project is completed.

We regret the interruption this change might create for individuals regularly using the Brickyard property but note that the area will reopen after the construction activities are completed.
