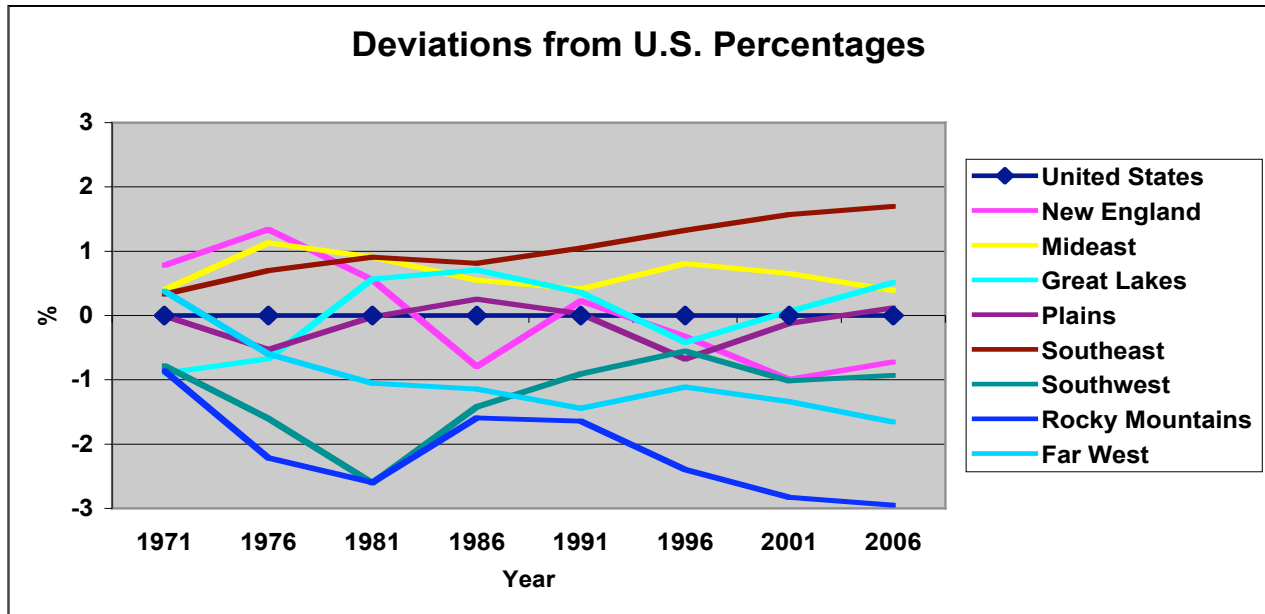
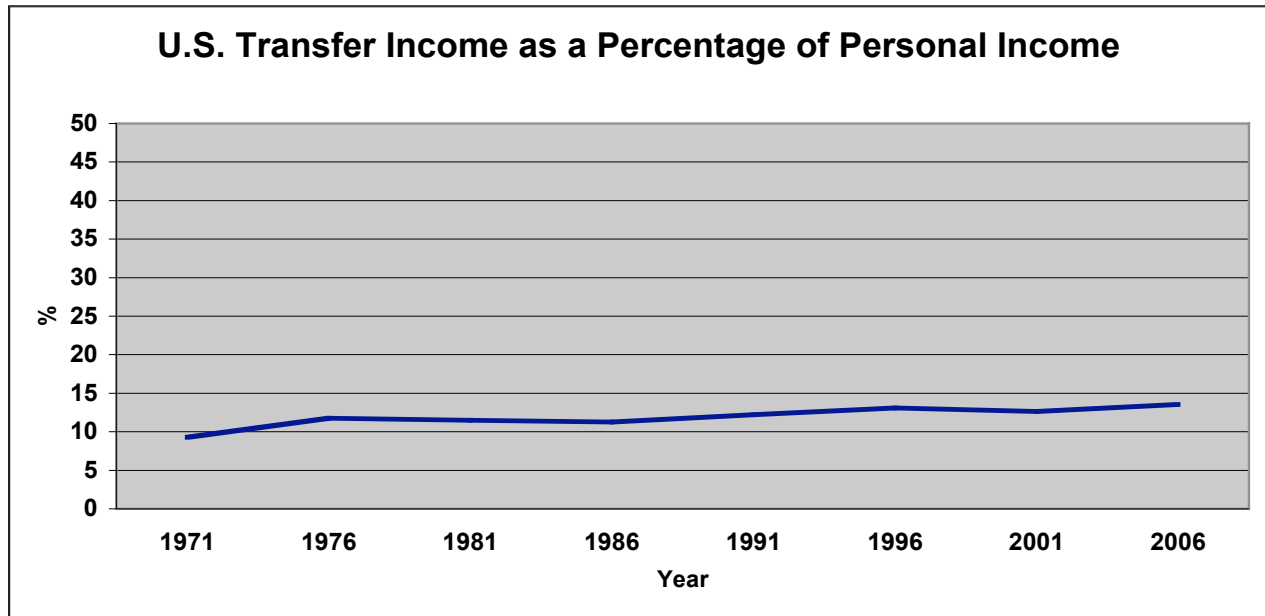


Transfer Income as a Percentage of Personal Income

The percentage of income received as transfer income throughout the United States has increased by about 4% over the past 35 years. There are wide regional variations from the U.S. percentage. The values for the Rocky Mountain and Far West Regions have remained notably below the U.S. average and are declining. The values for the Southeast Region, on the other hand, have been above the U.S. average and are on the rise.
