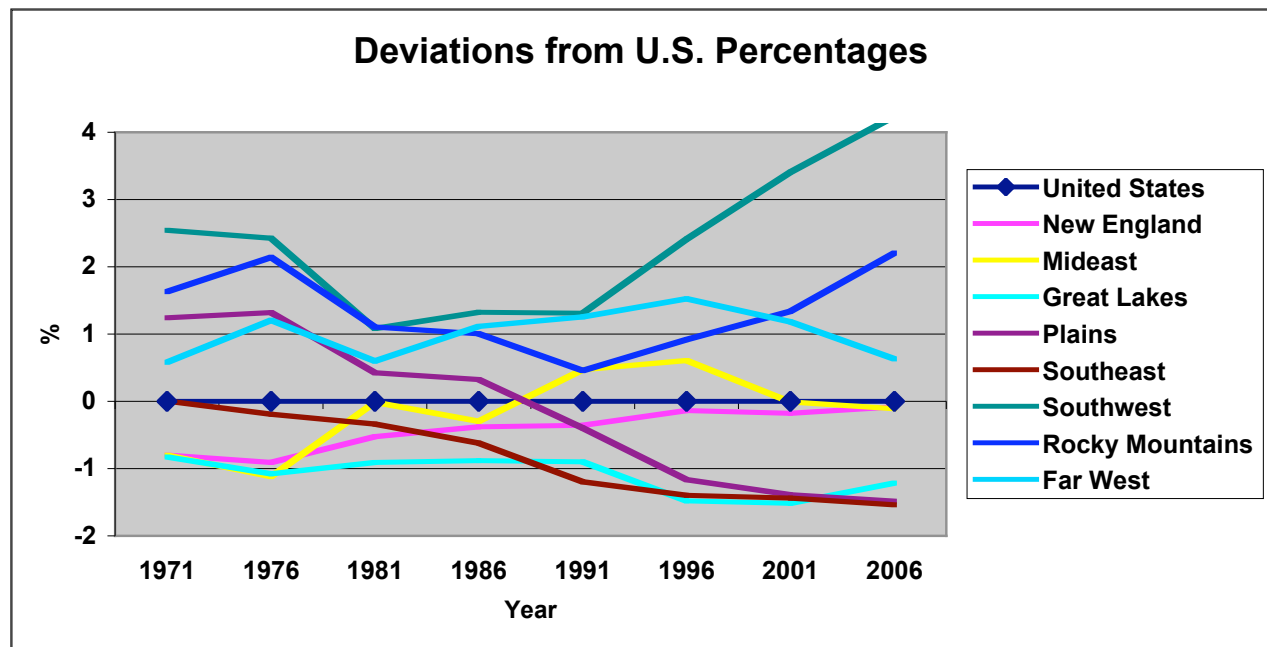
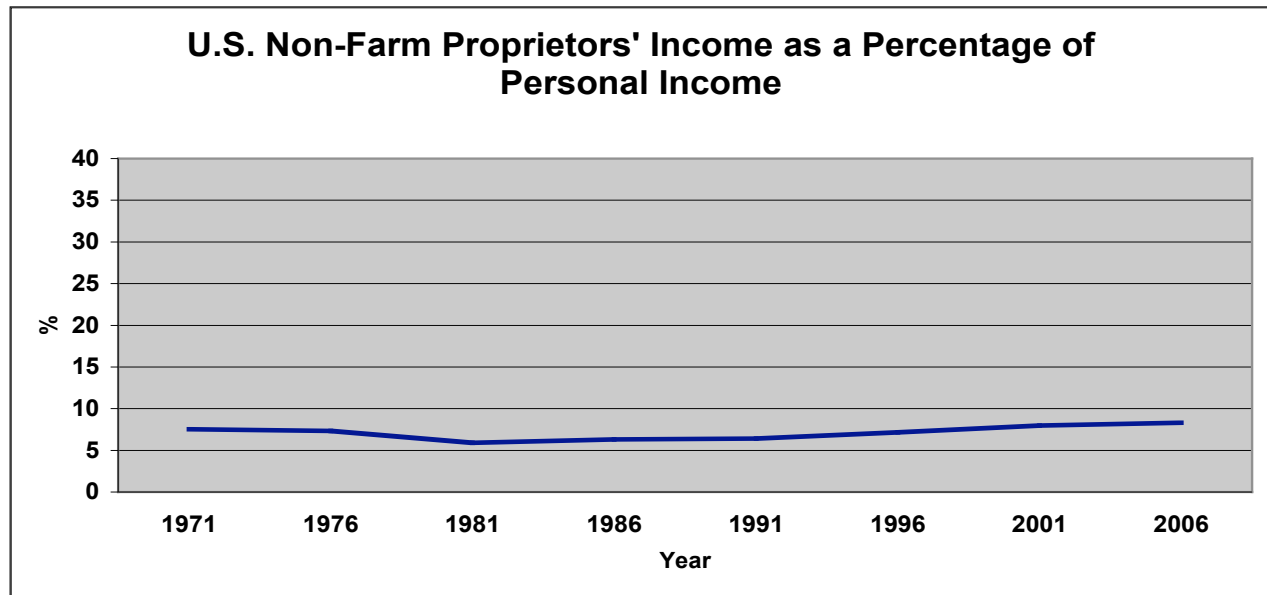


Non-Farm Proprietors' Income as a Percentage of Personal Income

Nationally, non-farm proprietors' income as a percentage of personal income decreased until the mid-1980s, but has now regained its prior value. There are currently very wide regional variations. The Southwest and Rocky Mountain Regions continue to increase their percentages over the U.S. level. However, the values for the Southeast, Far West, and Plains Regions all currently hover around 1.5% below the U.S. level.
