

Early Decision

You have two options to apply Early Decision to Franklin & Marshall College.

Round I Application deadline: **November 15**
 Notification date: **December 15**

Round II Application deadline: **January 15**
 Notification date: **February 15**

If accepted in either round of Early Decision, you are obligated to withdraw all other applications and enroll at Franklin & Marshall.

Early Decision Advantage

Franklin & Marshall values students who commit “early” to the College. Your early commitment places your application in a favorable light in the selection process. Statistically, students applying Early Decision are accepted at a higher rate than students applying Regular Decision.

Application Procedure

Complete and submit this form with the Common Application by either deadline listed above. If you will be a candidate for financial aid, please submit the required documents as outlined on the Financial Aid Web site: www.fandm.edu/financialaid. International students should use the Financial Aid Form for International Students. Interviews are required of Early Decision candidates, but students living a significant distance from the College may be exempt.
