# HISTORY *of the* COLLEGE

Franklin & Marshall College is one of the oldest institutions of higher learning in the United States. The College was founded in 1787 to bring culture and civility to what was then the Pennsylvania frontier. It began as Franklin College in the humble surroundings of a brew house on Mifflin Street, where the first classes were held on July 16, supported by a financial contribution from Benjamin Franklin. Other founders included four signers of the Declaration of Independence, three future governors of Pennsylvania, two members of the Constitutional Convention, and seven officers of the Revolutionary Army.

Since its founding, Franklin & Marshall has evolved through a series of transformative events into a nationally renowned liberal arts college that educates students from around the world. In 1853, Marshall College, a Mercersburg, Pa., institution named for Chief Justice John Marshall, moved to Lancaster to form Franklin & Marshall College. James Buchanan, 15th president of the United States, was the first president of the Board of Trustees. Beginning in its centennial year, the College added a strong program in science to its classical curriculum. Then, in the 1920s, it added a program in business. After World War II, a series of changes occurred that shaped the College into its present configuration. A longstanding connection to the German Reformed Church was severed and the College became a secular institution. The student body was no longer chiefly local, but became national and even international in scope. The numbers of students and faculty expanded, facilities were added, and the College became coeducational. Throughout all of these changes, the College remained committed to “liberal learning.”

Today, Franklin & Marshall proudly continues its dedication to intellectual freedom and critical learning. The College expects students to see connections, to discover community, and to understand the centrality of service to the human endeavor.

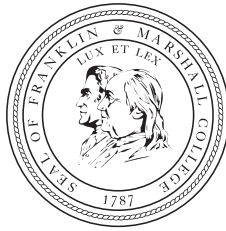

The Williamson Medal is the highest student award presented each year at Franklin & Marshall's Commencement. It is given to the member of the graduating class who has, during his or her senior year, reached the highest standing in character, leadership and scholarship. The medal was endowed by Owen Moon Jr., in memory of former trustee Henry S. Williamson, and has been presented annually since 1922. This year, the Williamson Medal is awarded to Menelaos Raptis.

Raptis is originally from Thessaloniki, Greece. He majored in astrophysics and minored in applied mathematics, and is graduating summa cum laude.

His honors thesis centered on his research into some of the smallest and faintest galaxies ever observed. In the fall, Raptis will begin a PhD program in astrophysics at Princeton University, on his way to becoming an astronaut.

Raptis spent a great deal of his time at F&M conducting research. After his first summer as a Hackman Scholar, he was chosen to participate in the Center for Interdisciplinary Exploration and Research in Astrophysics (CIERA) at Northwestern University, and then spent his third summer with CASSI (Carnegie Astrophysics Summer Student Internship) at the Carnegie Observatories. He also worked with several F&M professors, studying topics ranging from the mathematics of origami, to the aerodynamics of airplanes, to the physics of magic.

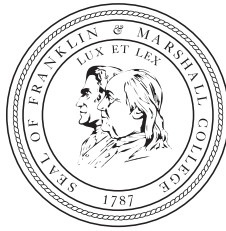
He assisted admission efforts, serving on multiple admitted-student panels and outreach initiatives, and engaging prospective students and families in conversations about research, campus life, and opportunities at F&M. Raptis maintained continued communication with international applicants, helping expand awareness of F&M within global academic communities.

In his first year, Raptis founded Space Week at F&M, and later, founded its successor, STEM Week; he was the local lead for the NASA Space Apps Challenge and was recognized as a "Stellar Lead"; he cofounded SCISTERS, an F&M community supporting women in STEM; he was an upper-level physics tutor and a preceptor/teaching assistant for introductory astronomy, served as president of both the Sigma Pi Sigma Physics and Astronomy Honor Society and the Pi Mu Epsilon Mathematics Honor Society, was a staff member at the Philadelphia Alumni Writers House, and was a member of the badminton club.

Menelaos, your academic research and dedicated involvement in campus life, together with your outstanding record of scholarship and commitment to intellectual growth, clearly demonstrate Franklin & Marshall College's ideal of developing graduates of intellect, character and leadership. You personify the spirit of the liberal arts and represent all that makes Franklin & Marshall College such a special place. Congratulations!

Troy Vincent Sr. is the executive vice president of football operations at the NFL. He has been a league executive with the NFL for 15 years, and he was an NFL player for 15 years before joining the NFL executive office. He played for the Miami Dolphins, Philadelphia Eagles, Buffalo Bills and Washington Commanders. Vincent also served as a player representative, executive committee member, and two-term president of the NFL Players Association.

Today, he works closely with clubs, players, and NFL legends on social justice initiatives in communities across the U.S. As co-chair of the Vision28 group, spearheading efforts to establish flag football as an Olympic sport, he has been instrumental in the global growth of American football.

Vincent, a father of five, is also a dedicated advocate against domestic violence and sexual assault. Both Vincent and his wife, Tommi, share a passion for and commitment to promoting the message of “Leadership Over Violence” and founded the Vincent Commission, in collaboration with Niagara University, to recommend best practices for prevention, educational approaches, and policy changes regarding domestic and gender-based violence. Vincent serves on the board of directors for the Love Thy Neighbor Foundation, the YMCA of the USA, the Roundabout Theatre Company, the Ross Initiative for Sports Equality (RISE), the American Football Coaches Association, and the Brian Dawkins Impact Foundation.

For his charitable endeavors, Vincent is the only player in history to have received the NFL Walter Payton Man of the Year award, NFL Players Association Byron Whizzer White Award, Sporting News #1 Good Guy, The Ed Block Courage Award, and NFL Athletes in Action Bart Starr Award. Vincent was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2023. He is the recipient of The National Coalition of Minority Football Coaches 2025 Trailblazer of the Year Award.

Vincent serves as a commissioner on the U.S. Commission on the Social Status of Black Men and Boys and the President’s Council on Sports, Fitness and Nutrition. He is the recipient of the National Jefferson Award for Public Service, and the Jesse Banks Foundation Humanitarian Award. He is recognized by Savoy Magazine as one of the Most Influential Black Executives in Corporate America and the Sports Business Journal as a Power Player for his work in sports technology. WayMaker Media selected Vincent to its 2025 Top 50 Black WayMakers for his commitment to the betterment of others.

An indefatigable and dynamic advocate for the Indigenous community and a preeminent voice for human rights, Robins is a transformative force in our region. Through her leadership with the Circle Legacy Center and her role as resident liaison to the Plain community for WellSpan Health, Robins has cultivated essential space for education, dialogue, and healing — work that is firmly rooted in her deep commitment to empathy, integrity, and community partnership.

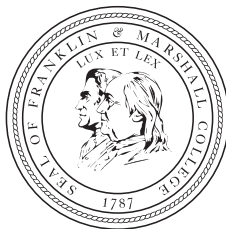
Robins' commitment to community-building led her to F&M's campus as Community Fellow for the inaugural year of the College's Mellon Foundation-funded Reckoning with Lancaster project. In this role, Robins was instrumental to the summer curricular institute for faculty and the Summer Research Scholar program for students. She also partnered with F&M professors to develop two classes, "Indigenous Histories in Lancaster" and "Indigenous Futures in Lancaster," imparting purpose, wisdom and local connection to students' learning.

Robins has dedicated her life's work to elevating Indigenous voices and forging enduring bonds between Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities throughout Lancaster. As an Onondaga who grew up on Haudenosaunee tribal lands in upstate New York and a Carlisle Indian School descendant, her leadership carries the weight of history, while also embodying hope for the future by turning history into a powerful catalyst for education, restoration, and visibility. She graduated from Boston College with a bachelor's degree in biology and worked as an interpreter in the Wampanoag history program at Plimoth Plantation in Massachusetts.

John Fry is the president of Temple University and the former president of Drexel University. He was the 14th president of Franklin & Marshall College, and served from 2002 to 2010.

Fry earned his bachelor's degree in American civilization from Lafayette College and his MBA from New York University's Stern School of Business.

As F&M's president, Fry reshaped the campus, strengthened residential life and the student experience, expanded the faculty, and championed an outward-looking, community-engaged philosophy that still guides the College today.

Under his leadership, F&M launched its distinctive College House system, built a new residence hall, and hired 40 new faculty, leading to the institution's current 9-to-1 student-faculty ratio. Fry also spearheaded the strategic acquisition of land adjacent to the north end of F&M's campus, a move that cleared the way for the development of Shadek Stadium and the College's premier multipurpose playing fields. By partnering with Lancaster General Health, he further evolved the area into an important educational-medical corridor.

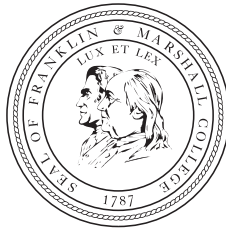
At F&M, Fry's vision helped set the foundation for a thriving, collaborative relationship between the College and the City of Lancaster — one that continues to grow. He helped launch the James Street Improvement District, which led to economic redevelopment, as well as additional housing for students. He engaged city and community leaders and worked to make city revitalization a priority for the College.

His contributions as the president of Drexel University and Temple University reflect the same dedication to innovation, engagement, and excellence that left a lasting mark on F&M's campus. He is a nationally recognized educational leader and a tireless innovator, and is an elected member of the American Philosophical Society, a scholarly organization founded by Benjamin Franklin in 1743.

A pillar of the Lancaster community, Susan Eckert has spent decades shaping the city into a stronger, more connected group of neighbors. Her tireless commitment to Lancaster organizations has left a lasting mark on nearly every corner of the community's professional and civic life.

A longtime vocal advocate for the needs of Lancaster County families, Eckert is well known for her 25 years as the head of the United Way of Lancaster County. Under her leadership, United Way empowered generosity with purpose — giving donors a voice, mobilizing hundreds of volunteers, and bringing people together to direct resources where they were needed most. She was at the forefront of caring for the community's most vulnerable, and developing programs that increased both results and accountability.

That commitment to service has been a hallmark of Eckert's leadership, enhancing her work as executive director of the YWCA, principal of the Eckert Group, and director of advancement at the Family Medicine Education Consortium. Beyond her broad community impact, Eckert serves on the advisory board for the Eckert Art Gallery, an important exhibition space at Millersville University. Through their annual sponsorship of art exhibitions and student interns for the gallery, she and her husband, Jerry, actively foster local talent. Their endowed scholarship — established in honor of Susan's mother, Dorothy Connolly — provides life-changing support for nontraditional students.

Eckert has also served on many local boards of directors, including WITF, the Lancaster County Local Journalism Fund, and the newly formed Always Lancaster. Eckert earned her bachelor's degree in history from William Smith College and her master's degree in education from Boston College. She is widely respected for her unwavering dedication to improving the lives of others, and for the humility and heart with which she has led her teams. We are fortunate to count her as a friend of Franklin & Marshall College.



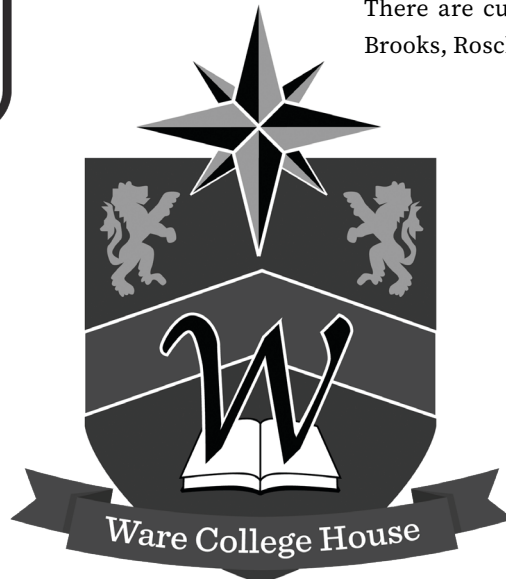
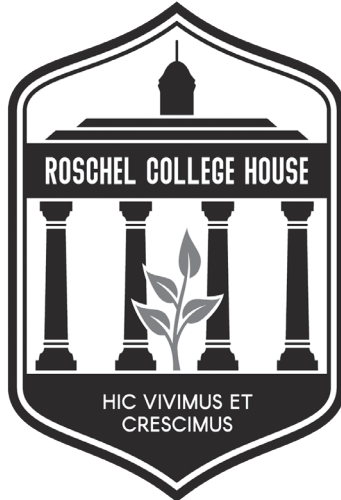

# THE COLLEGE HOUSES

College Houses provide a crucial crossroads for faculty, students, distinguished visitors and alumni. They are “third spaces,” neither classrooms nor residential halls, that fill a need intimately connected with the nature of a liberal arts education. The Houses offer faculty and students a setting for chance encounters and informal moments, as well as scheduled opportunities that spark students’ potential, engage their intellectual imaginations, and connect them with alumni and current and future notables in environments that are stimulating, comfortable, and educational in the deepest sense.

The Houses are the meeting ground where students can interact and network among the extended College family. On any given day, students might encounter a government official, visiting alumni, distinguished scholars, candidates interviewing for positions at the College, faculty hosting small discussions, or CEOs looking for talent. Students create and host social events that bring them together with other members of the House and with the extended F&M community.

In these ways, the House environment integrates thoughtful deliberation and intellectual exploration into students’ daily lives. This frequent engagement with ideas and exposure to disparate views helps students to form habits of thought and analysis that will vitalize their professional and personal lives. There are currently five College Houses: Bonchek, Brooks, Roschel, Ware, and Weis.

## THE COLLEGE MACE

The maple and poplar College Mace was designed by Professor Edmund Whiting, chair of the Department of Art at Franklin & Marshall College, in 1967–68 and created by J.E. Brubaker Pattern Works, formerly of Landisville, Pa. The mace is a replica of the four-spired tower of Old Main, one of the oldest buildings on campus. Inside the mace is a piece of an oak beam taken from the North Queen Street building where Franklin College established its quarters in 1788, less than a year after its founding. Since it was presented to the College by the Alumni Association at Franklin & Marshall's 189th Commencement on Sunday, June 11, 1967, the mace has become an official emblem of the College at ceremonial events.

## THE ALUMNI TORCH

On the occasion of its 20th reunion in 1924, the Class of 1904 presented the College with a ceremonial torch, principally for use at Commencement. The members of the class hoped to create a new tradition in which the torch would be ceremonially handed from the Alumni Board president to the president of the senior class. This literal and symbolic “passing of the torch” was intended to welcome the newest graduates into the ranks of alumni.

For more than 75 years, this tradition was a centerpiece of Commencement. Unfortunately, the torch disappeared during the 2000 ceremony and has never been found. The Alumni Association, with the help of the Class of 2004 (in a fitting tribute to its predecessors of a century before), commissioned the creation of a new torch that is an exact replica of the original. This tradition has now been renewed.

## THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Founded in 1840, the Alumni Association of Franklin & Marshall College is one of the oldest in the country. It initially served as an intellectual society for graduates, who each year designated one of their members “Orator” and listened to his remarks on some current issue or philosophical problem at the annual meeting.

As the College evolved, so did the association. Following the merger of Franklin College and Marshall College in 1853, members of the original Marshall Association enthusiastically pledged themselves to their new institution. In 1874, the association incorporated in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Regional chapters were soon formed, beginning in 1887 in Philadelphia, followed by the Southern Association (in Maryland) in 1890, the Lancaster chapter in 1894 and the Eastern Association (in Reading) in 1900. In the first decades of the 20th century, the association grew in size and in its ambitions. By 1937, there were 17 chapters across the country, including New York City, Baltimore, Washington, D.C., and as far west as Cleveland and Chicago.

The Franklin & Marshall Alumni Association today boasts chapters across the United States and hosts activities around the world. It serves nearly 30,000 alumni—who hold leadership positions in virtually every profession—through networking opportunities, social events, cultural programs and a dedicated career-services officer who provides alumni with support in areas such as career advisement, job placement, and job strategy assistance and skills assessment.

The Alumni Association also works to enhance the experience of current students. The board of directors of the Alumni Association supports two scholarships, hosts a celebration each Commencement weekend for graduates and, in recent years, has made important financial contributions to key strategic initiatives of the College.

Though times change, the spirit of the Alumni Association's mission endures: “to advance the welfare of the College and its alumni by engaging alumni in the life of their alma mater; fostering and strengthening the connections between and among alumni, students and the rest of the College community; and inspiring in alumni and students a lifelong sense of loyalty toward, pride in, and support of the College.”
