

CURRENT STATUS AS OF January 13, 2022



Alert Level Descriptions

- **LOW ALERT:** Campus and/or community COVID-19 transmission levels are low and show no pattern to suggest they may be increasing.
- **MODERATE ALERT:** Campus and/or community COVID-19 transmission levels are moderate. The number of positive cases is easily managed through contact tracing and quarantine and isolation. The number of infections among vaccinated individuals is small.
- **HIGH ALERT:** Campus and/or community COVID-19 transmission levels are high. The number of potential exposures is rising. The number of positive cases is manageable through contact tracing and quarantine and isolation, but capacity may be decreasing. Breakthrough infections are occurring with substantial frequency.
- **VERY HIGH ALERT:** Campus and/or community COVID-19 transmission levels are very high and occurring at an accelerating rate. Contact tracing and quarantine and isolation is near or beyond capacity. There is no indication that the situation will improve in the near term.

As F&M is between semesters, this week's dashboard contains only the graphs showing the local situation.

Please note that there are reliability issues with the data presented below due to (1) challenges faced by the public health authorities in keeping up with the reported cases and (2) the fact that many positive cases through at-home tests are not reported.
